CHALLENGE

Stephen Lyons manages the QHSE Department of the GEM Group, comprising of three operating businesses focused on Construction, Joinery, and Development. Stephen needed a way to streamline his access to information for both tenders and projects that GEM had won. Stephen noted how GEM Group had an outdated system that would require a large investment to get to the place where they wanted to be. Stephen's key focus was to find a system that could improve the ease, efficiency and quality of Health & Safety information, while reducing complexity and data duplication.

SOLUTION
